BLETIERE VENUE RULES

LAKE RULES

- Fish safety and care are the two most important concerns. All fish caught must be returned alive. We have tried to keep the rules to a minimum and trust your common sense.
- No sacks or keepnets. We **do not supply** landing nets, mats or slings. All anglers must have nets and mats that are large enough to handle very large carp and all swims in use must have them in place. To save space we can hire mats and slings. All landing nets must be at least 42 inches and please ensure they are thoroughly dry before using them.
- Do not stand up to take photos of fish! Keep close to mats and weigh all fish in slings and always hold fish above mats.
- Please spray all cuts and any wounds on fish with antiseptic we will supply.
- No more than 3 rods per angler and no rods to be left unattended. This includes anglers with remote alarms. Rods must not be left out and anglers walk to gite or other swims.
- Rig tubing must be used and at least 24 inches long, this helps stop cuts on fish.
- Barbless or micro barbed hooks only and all rigs must be safe rigs and not fixed. Line on carp rods must be at least 12lb and on float rods 5lb.
- No nut baits of any sort to be used e.g. tiger or peanuts.
- Only commercially prepared particles to be used. Because not all anglers know how to prepare particles safely we can supply them to save you space if you prefer.
- We stock a range of Quest Baits boilies, but please order in advance so we can ensure we have what you want.
- No litter to be left in swims or on the banks. Please use the bins supplied. Please do not leave cigarette ends on the bank or fields... put them in bins. No fires... but BBQ's on lags are OK.
- No swimming or wading in the lake and no fishing from island. No cars to be driven down to lake as the ground is very soft in places.
- Radios allowed on the lake as long as they are kept quite.
- Please do not use the banks as a toilet; there is an additional toilet in the barn.
- No children under 16 years old to fish alone. Please watch your children as water is dangerous. We cannot take responsibility for your child's safety and we do not supply lifejackets.

GITE RULES

- The gite will be available from 2pm on day of arrival and must be vacated by 10am on day of departure.
- A deposit of £150 cash will be asked for at the start of your holiday and this will be returned when you leave providing no breakages or damage has occurred.
- Please leave the gite as you will find it, clean and tidy.
- No fishing tackle or bait to be stored in gite, please use the barn.
- No muddy boots in the gite - please leave them in the barn.
- Please only park in designated areas as the ground is soft in other places.
- No smoking or pets allowed in the gite. Please use bins for cigarette ends and not the floor.
- Please do not remove the information pack left in gite; it is for all our visitors.
- At the end of your stay please leave the BBQ as you will find it, clean.
- Furnishings from the gite must not be used outside and the bed linen supplied must stay in the gite.
- We are connected to fosse septic toilets so please do not put any materials other than toilet paper down them. Also please do not put bleach or similar products down toilets and sinks.

TACKLE HIRE

To save you taking up valuable car space the following tackle is available to hire:

- Bedchair..... 20€ a week.
- Large mat and a sling...10€ a week per angler.
- 3 rods, reels, alarms, rod pod..... 50€ a week. (terminal tackle not supplied).

However, these items do need to be reserved in advance - ring the office for details.
